Timings:

9:30	Registration starts. Please arrive in time to collect music and find your place.
10:00	Warm up and first session.
11:15	Break for drinks and cake.
11:25	Second session.
13:00	Lunch
13:45	Third session.
14:45	Break for drinks and cake.
15:00	Performance.
16:00	Finish.

Parking:

There is parking at Aspley Guise Village Hall. This is limited to the extent that we park in rows down the middle of the car park for rehearsals. This can make it difficult for anyone who needs to leave before the end of the day to get out. Therefore

- If it is possible, please try to share a car with friends.
- If you think you might want to leave before the end of the day, please consider parking in the village.

Turn up Woburn Lane, between Moore Place and the Blue Orchid, at the roundabout. Then turn left into Spinney Lane and the car park is on your right.

Tickets:

There will be a list of participants at a desk by the car park door. Please go to the desk when you arrive to register your attendance (and pay if you have not done so already). If you are not a member of the chorus, please tell the people doing registration how you heard about the day.

Scores:

There will be scores available to borrow. If you mark your copies, please rub out all your markings before you hand back at the end of the day.

Refreshments:

There will be cakes available at all breaks, as well as coffee, tea, hot chocolate and soft drinks. If you would like to make a donation to the choir in recognition of our cake bakers, there will be baskets set out at the milk and sugar stations as well as our card reader in the cake room.

You will need to bring your own lunch and there will be break out spaces within the building as well as the main hall.

Housekeeping:

Photography: there will be a member of the choir taking photographs during the day. If you don't wish to appear in photographs, please let us know at registration.

Toilets: if queues develop, there are a couple of extra toilets for the women behind the stage. These are down a couple of flights of stairs, so not suitable for those with restricted movement.

Feedback: we would value your feedback about what you enjoyed, what could be improved and ideas for future works. There will be cards set out around the hall during the final break if you would like to share your thoughts.
