1 Introduction

2 Rehearsals

- 1) Attend rehearsals regularly and punctually whenever possible.
- 2) Work at learning the music to the best of your ability.
- 3) Do ask for help if you are struggling.
- 4) Treat all members, staff and visitors with courtesy and respect.

3 Interactions

Please do treat everyone equally and equitably, and with consideration dignity and respect. We hope and expect that you will be treated in line with this, but please do report to your voice rep or the membership secretary if this has not been the case.
